

To All LD 18 Members

Most of you have received a notice with information concerning this Saturday's very important Pima County GOP Statutory meeting.

There is a lot to say about this meeting; from the short notice, exceptionally high cost, over-restrictive procedures and bylaw proposals that go against Arizona Revised Statutes.

It is your responsibility to review this material and make your own plan - but DO plan to be there early as there are restrictive check-in times and requirements.

Parking is within two blocks and you can park on the street.

Refreshments unknown.

Seating is specified by Legislative District.

Time limit is unknown.

But what I do know is that the proposed bylaws amendments were written and developed to restrict ALL Legislative Districts to be under the thumb of the County Chairman.

It looks like our PC outreach over the past campaign season was very successful, with over 35 new PCs in LD18, over 25 in LD 17 and over 20 in the other LDs. However, the bylaw amendments were written and developed to limit any and all ability of our newly acquired "appointed" Precinct Committeemen to have any voice, say or opportunity to become involved in making our "Big Tent," "Grassroots" organization anything but that.

The bylaws amendments eliminate Proxies at the county and district levels.

These bylaw amendments were never publicly discussed and the 12 bylaws proposals delivered by LD18 were not responded to or discussed.

While LD18 asked members to join our Bylaws Committee, the Pima County Chairman hand-picked her associates to write and format her desired changes behind closed doors to be force fed to you at the Pima GOP Statutory Meeting this Saturday.

Last night, the Legislative District 18 Executive Board met and UNANIMOUSLY voted to oppose all of the County Bylaws proposals in total.

It is with the highest concern that the LD18 Executive Board urges all members of LD18 to attend this Saturday and vote against All of the County Bylaws Proposals.

It was also voted upon that the LD18 Executive Board unanimously endorsed the entire "Copper Ticket" for election to office for Pima County GOP offices.

This is a turning point for the GOP in southern Arizona!
